# The Barefoot Boy From Brazil

## Biography

People all over the world love to watch sports such as baseball, football, basketball, and soccer. Fans travel to stadiums by the thousands to cheer on their favorite teams. Every four years, soccer fans flock to the World Cup tournament. It is soccer's most famous and important event. This event isn't just a national contest like the Super Bowl or World Series. Teams come from all over the world to play. The winner becomes the champion of the whole world!



Soccer is a team sport that requires all of its players to perform their tasks in order for them to be successful. Even so, every once in a while there is a player that really stands out. One such player was simply known as Pele (pay-LAY). He was born in 1940. His poor family lived in a small town in Brazil. When Pele was born, he was named Edson. He was named after the famous American inventor, Thomas Edison. A Irish priest visited the slum areas where young Edson lived. He noticed Edson's skill and often told him to "play football" in Irish. It sounded a lot like Pele, so the other kids called him Pele and the nickname stuck.

Pele's father was a professional soccer player. But unlike professional athletes in America today, he made very little money. Pele's mother didn't want her son to play soccer. She thought that would keep him in a life of poverty. But despite his mother's fears, Pele wanted to be a soccer player.
